I believe listening is powerful medicine. Studies have shown it takes a doctor about 18 seconds to interrupt a patient after he begins talking.

It was Sunday. 81 I got into her room. She was an old woman, sitting at the edge of the bed, trying to put socks on her feet. When she saw me, she asked if I could help put on her socks. Usually I asked my patients something like this: "How are you feeling? The nurse said your son is visiting you today. 82 "

She stopped me with a serious voice. "Sit down, doctor. This is my story, not your story. "

I was surprised and embarrassed. I sat down. 83 She began to tell me that her only son lived around the corner from her, but she had not seen him for five years. She believed her health problems were worse because of the stress of missing her son. After hearing her story and putting on her socks, I asked if there was anything else I could do for her. 84 All she wanted me to do was to listen.

Each story is different. Some are clear; others are not. Some have a beginning, middle and end. Others wander without a clear ending. Some are true; others are not. 85 What matters to the storyteller is that the story is heard — without interruption or judgment.

Listening to someone's story costs less than expensive diagnostic testing but is key to healing (康复). I often thought of what that woman taught me, and I reminded myself of the importance of stopping, sitting down and truly listening.

For as long as I could, I continued to see patients. I still teach my students and other health care professionals, but now from the view of doctor and patient. I tell them I believe in the power of listening.

Swine flu has happened in Mexico in the last few weeks. Some people have died from swine flu. Many of those who died were young adults.

Until May 6<sup>th</sup>, students stay at home. Restaurants and churches are closed. The government also stopped people from going to sports, concerts and similar events. But many Mexicans have criticized the country's health measures.

The disease has spread to at least 7 countries and is suspected in others. The United States has more than 48 confirmed cases in 5 states. But no one has died from swine flu in this country. The United States government agreed the use of federal money and the use of flu medicines in federal storage. American officials so far have released about 12 million treatments of Tamiflu and sent them to the states. They say additional supplies are available if needed. President Obama has said officials are being watchful, not fearful. The United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention is advising people to avoid travel to Mexico. This is the news from VOA.

Beijing: Though no swine flu case has been reported on the Chinese mainland, the Ministry of Health (MOH) has set up a working team to coordinate with the Ministry of Agriculture and GAQSIQ to monitor the situation and deal with any emergency.

China will offer humanitarian aid worth \$5 million to Mexico, the Foreign Ministry said on Wednesday. The emergency humanitarian assistance comes in the wake of the epidemic of swine flu, and includes \$ one million in cash and material aid worth \$ 4 million, the ministry said.
